Welcome to Faust's Summer Theatre 2018

During the summer, our members meet daily over the space of a week and explore different aspects of the performing world with a particular focus on developing performance skills, exploring drama values and learning about drama in its wider social and cultural context. Some of the learning outcomes of workshops include:

Performance Skills

- Creative use of voice to develop characters, express feelings and project and control volume
- Use of body, gesture and movement to create meaning, develop characters and to express feelings
- Interpret and use scripts
- Understand different points of view as well as staying focused when performing
- Understand blocking and movement on stage and develop an awareness of audience and visually pleasing positions on stage
- Understand how to use props, costume and set confidently and creatively



Drama in Context

- Understand and appreciate different theatre practitioners and the inspirations behind them
- Understand the different roles in the theatre e.g Director, Choreographer, Stage Manager, etc
- Apply drama to everyday situations such as storytelling, presentations and debating

Drama Values

- Respect self and others
- Appreciate connections between own and characters' experiences
- Learn and experience the value of trust and taking risks
- Share thoughts and feelings through reflection and be willing to justify interpretations and preferences
- Evaluate personal and group performance and identify areas for improvement

About our Workshops

Each week, under the careful guidance of our experienced and enthusiastic workshops leaders, children explore a different drama theme, play or topic. Workshops are tailored to the needs and age of the children, to increase their skills, confidence and enjoyment of learning.



Workshop Structure

The week starts with ice-breaking activities helping the children to become comfortable in their new environment, allowing them to get to know each other and encouraging them to be proactive and supportive



The workshops then focus on development of performance skills such as improvisation, devising, clarity of expression, vocal projection, movement or script work.

Our youngest age groups (3 to 4 and 4 to 5) will demonstrate the skills they have learnt and our older learners (aged 5 and above) will share their learning through a short performance inspired by their week's work.



Workshops are led by a Group Leader who is an experienced teacher and drama practitioner and an Assistant Leader with a drama or education background.

The age groups available include: 3 to 4, 4 to 5, 5 to 6, 6 to 8, 8 to 11 and 11 to 14.

New Content Each Week

We update our content every year with new scripts, stories and themes that allows the children to join multiple weeks. Inspiration for our younger groups often comes from well known children's books and fairytales. Stimulus for older students includes exciting adaptations of well known literary tales and dynamic adventure stories with a wide variety of fun characters to perform.

Ages 3 to 4

We provide a safe and welcoming environment for our youngest members. We use structured exercises, led by a trained team of leaders, to help children take their first steps in front of an audience with excitement and confidence.



Ages 4 to 5, 5 to 6 and 6 to 8

As our young actors develop confidence we focus on the actor's tools - the voice, body and imagination. Using stories and other creative activities we develop drama skills, encourage creative expression and devise our own interpretation of characters and stories.



Ages 8 to 11

Building on the actor's tools, we add more challenging exercises and explore different theatre genres. The wide range of scripts will call for strong characterisation, physical theatre techniques, stage awareness and more to bring out a more skilled and confident performer.



Ages 11 to 14

Our oldest group has lots to get involved in. We push their boundaries and challenge them through devising, script work, improvisation and other more specialist skills. Our actors will explore characterisation in detail, as well as staging whilst also, of course, having lots of fun!

Our small-group courses unlock the potential of our young writers, encourage creativity and develop writing skills.

Aims of our Creative Writing Workshops

We aim to give children a dedicated time to focus on their writing, to share their ideas and to learn new things. Our courses help children to:

- Learn how to express themselves through writing
- Learn new writing techniques
- Complement and enhance existing good writing practices
- Develop their imagination and allow ideas to flourish
- Increase confidence within their comfort zone and allow them to try new things
- Be empowered to make strong choices with their writing
- Head back to school ready for the creative writing opportunities ahead
- Experience a supportive learning environment with positive feedback
- Enjoy the writing process



Learning for All Levels

Under the careful instruction of our experienced creative writing teachers, children look at different aspects of creative writing including metaphors, similes, dialogue, poetry, descriptive techniques and genre writing, to list but a few. Whether a student is an aspiring writer or a novice, our students will have plenty to write about!

Please note these courses are designed for children with native or a high level of fluency in English, and are not designed as an English as a Second Language programme.

Workshop Structure

Our creative writing classes start with a warm up activity designed to get the children comfortable as well as giving everyone a chance to express their ideas and thoughts. We then focus on the particular topic or theme for the week. Our limited class size (maximum of 8 students) allows plenty of time for discussion, as well as group and individual feedback. At the end of the lesson we review what we have done and share what we have learnt and how we will apply this in our writing.

New Content Each Week

We update our content every year and are inspired by acclaimed writers such as Roald Dahl, J.K. Rowling, Michael Morpurgo, Julia Donaldson, Philip Pullman, Neil Gaiman and more. We also explore many different writing genres and tropes suitable for their age range.

We have the following age groups on offer:

Ages 6 to 7

We focus on capturing thoughts and ideas on paper. As emergent writers it is important to develop confidence in addition to great writing techniques. We explore stories, as well as playing lots of games to get children thinking and writing!

Ages 7 to 9 or 8 to 10

We focus on channelling creativity, providing an outlet for it as well as learning from others. We will investigate more complex writing mechanisms and learn the value of feedback and editing.

Ages 10 to 13

For our oldest writers it is time to challenge the conventional, to encourage thinking outside the box and to make writing even more sophisticated. We will look at a variety of different writers for inspiration and develop our own writing style.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can my child do Summer Theatre & Creative Writing in the same week?

Yes, as long as your child is the right age! Many children choose this option as it is a great way to get the mind and body engaged and creative! Wherever possible we schedule workshops so children can do both programmes in one day.

What is taught in Faust's Summer Programmes?

Each week brings a different focus and theme with content tailored to the age range of the group. Parents are informed through workshop reports (Summer Theatre) or weekly schedules (Creative Writing) of what their child is doing.

My child is very shy. Will he or she enjoy the workshops?

Yes, our workshops are designed for shy through to confident children. Leaders work within a child's comfort zone, encouraging and supporting them.

Does my child need to have had any drama or creative writing experience?

No, children come to workshops with different levels of experience. An interest in drama or creative writing and a fluency in English are important.

How can I get a discount?

We offer an Summer Loyalty Rate (10% discount) which is available for those who sign up for more than one week, more than one sibling, or for both Summer Theatre and Creative Writing. Discounts cannot be combined.

Will I get to see what my child has accomplished?

For Summer Theatre, each child can invite 2 guests (friends and family) to an end of week open session. Our younger members will share their learning and our older learners will demonstrate their skills and knowledge in an end of week performance.

For Creative Writing, children bring their work home at the end of the week. Our teachers will also be happy to give you feedback about your child's progress.

If my child joins a Faust Summer Programme can they continue with their drama lessons?

Yes, we run after school and Saturday drama workshops during term time. As a member of our Summer Programme you will be sent details of all our courses.

What's the policy in terms of weather?

All workshops will be cancelled in the event of Typhoon Signal No.8 or higher, or black rain warning if hoisted at 7am for morning workshops and 12noon for afternoon workshops. No refunds, make up classes or credit notes will be made in this case.
