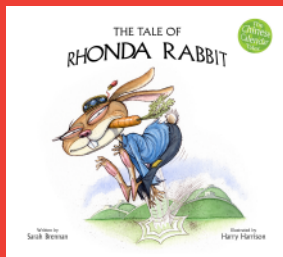




Chinese New Year 2011 Play in a Day
